# UNOPPOSED MOTION OF ARISTOTLE INTERNATIONAL, INC. FOR LEAVE TO FILE AMICUS CURIAE BRIEF

Pursuant to Local Rule 7(o)(2), Aristotle International Inc. ("Aristotle") respectfully submits this unopposed motion for leave to file an *amicus curiae* brief in support of Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment.

Aristotle has an interest in this litigation because Aristotle has applied to operate a Designated Contract Market ("DCM"), which would allow it to operate similarly to Kalshi, the Plaintiff in this matter. Aristotle's application is currently pending before the CFTC. If Aristotle's application is approved, Aristotle intends to offer contracts similar to those offered by Kalshi on a DCM.

Aristotle is able to bring unique insight into this matter that neither party is able to adequately represent. Aristotle is thus able to bring both its unique experience and data, which is relevant to several of the issues in this litigation.
