This notice is to inform the Court of relevant new precedent regarding venue transfer under 28 U.S.C. § 1404(a) from federal courts in the Fifth Circuit to federal courts in this district in cases involving judicial review of federal agency action. The new decision was issued by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas on March 28, 2024, one day after the CFTC filed its supplemental briefing on venue retransfer in this case. The new precedent is *Chamber of Commerce of the United States of America v. Consumer Financial Protection Bureau*, No. 4:24-cv-00213-P, Dkt. 67 (N.D. Tex. March 28, 2024).
