NOTICE OF VACATUR ON GROUNDS NOT RELEVANT TO THIS CASE OF RELEVANT PRECEDENT ISSUED BY ANOTHER COURT FOLLOWING COMPLETION OF SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFING BY DEFENDANT CFTC

On March 29, 2024 the CFTC informed the Court of relevant post-briefing precedent regarding venue transfer under 28 U.S.C. § 1404(a) from federal courts in the Fifth Circuit to federal courts in this district, specifically, *Chamber of Commerce of the United States of America v. Consumer Financial Protection Bureau*, No. 4:24-cv-00213-P, Dkt. 67 (N.D. Tex. March 28, 2024). This notice is to inform the Court that the Northern District of Texas decision has been vacated by the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit on jurisdictional grounds unrelated to the merits of the district court's venue decision. *In re Fort Worth Chamber of Commerce*, No. 24-10266, Dkt. 33-1 (5th Cir. April 5, 2024). The merits of the venue decision were discussed in a concurring opinion and a dissent but the opinion for the court expressly

declined to address the venue transfer issue beyond holding that, in the circumstances of the case, the district court lacked jurisdiction to issue a transfer order due to a pending interlocutory appeal on another issue. *See id. at* 2. A copy of the Fifth Circuit decision is attached.
