**[proposed] ORDER GRANTING CFTC’S MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO COMPLY
WITH THE COURT’S JANUARY 8, 2025, ORDER**

On January 31, 2025, Defendant, United States Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC”), filed a Motion to extend by 30 days the time to comply with the Court’s January 8, 2025 Order which required the CFTC to produce certain materials and provide an affidavit regarding the completeness of the administrative record by February 7, 2025. The Court, having reviewed the motion, finds that the CFTC has shown good cause for an extension of the February 7, 2025 deadline and the CFTC’s Motion is therefore GRANTED. The time for the CFTC to comply with the Court’s January 8, 2025, order is extended by 30 days to March 7, 2025.
