[proposed] ORDER GRANTING CFTC’S MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULING ORDER TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS

On February 11, 2025, the Commodity Futures Trading Commission filed a Motion to amend the Court's Scheduling Order (ECF No. 94) to extend the March 10, 2025, deadline for filing dispositive motions until further order of the Court or, in the alternative, until September 10, 2025; and to adjust the date for disclosure of witnesses and exhibits accordingly.
